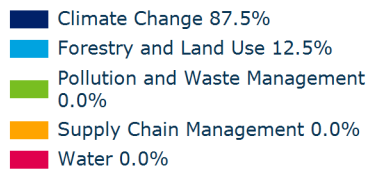
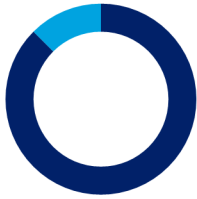

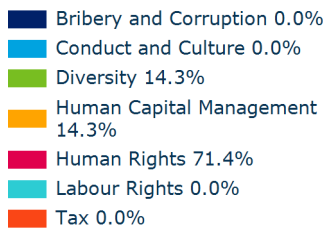
Environmental

Social and Ethical topics featured in 20.0% of our engagements



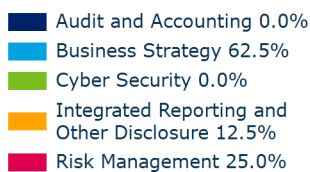
Governance
